

Children enrolled in AM care at Katonah, Lewisboro, and Increase Miller Elementary Schools can be dropped off at the White House beginning at 9:00 AM and will be sent by district bus to their respective schools.
- 2) In the event of a SCHOOL CLOSING, children enrolled in CCVC can be dropped off at the White House be ginning at 9:00AM. Only children enrolled in CCVC are eligible for care if the school closes due to weather conditions.
